**Temporary Closure of Etsome Hill, Barpool Lane and Lugshorn Lane.**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Etsome Hill** - from the junction with Barpool Lane, southwards for a distance of **1020 metres**;  
**Barpool Lane** - from the junction with Etsome Hill, eastwards for a distance of **200 metres**, and  
**Lugshorn Lane**- from the junction with Barpool Lane, northwards fo a distance of **80 metres**.  
A total distance of **1300 metres**

This Order will enable **Wessex Internet to install fibre cable**.

The Order becomes effective on 06th June 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **10th June 2024** and last until **14th June 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **5 days**.
