Temporary Closure of Kingweston Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Kingweston Road - from 110 metres west of the junction with Welham, westwards for a total distance of **97 metres**.

This Order will enable **Xeiad to carry out a bridge inspection on behalf of Network Rail**.

The Order becomes effective on 20th June 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. These works were expected to commence on **25th June 2024**.

These works will now commence on **26th June 2024** and last until **27th June 2024** between the hours of **21:00 - 05:00** for a total of **1 night**.
