

**Somerset Council**

**Temporary Closure of Friarn Street**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Friarn Street** - from the junction with Priory Court to the junction Silver Street. A total distance of **80 metres**.

This Order will enable **Wessex Water to carry out new connection works**.

The Order becomes effective on 20th August 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **27th August 2024** and last until **30th August 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **4 days**.
