## Temporary Closure of Lane Off Chatham Avenue and Rear Access to 2-32 Chatham Avenue

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Lane Off Chatham Avenue -** from the junction with Chatham Avenue to the junction with Rear Access to 2-32 Chatham Avenue:

**Rear Access to 2-32 Chatham Avenue -** from the junction with Lane off Chatham Avenue, southwestwards for a distance of **53 meters**.

A total distance of **99 metres**.

This Order will enable National Grid to replace a pole.

The Order becomes effective on 27th August 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **5th September 2024** and last until **13th September 2024** between the hours of **09:30** - **15:30** ( **Monday - Friday only**) for a total of **9 days**.
