Temporary Closure of Peak Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Peak Lane - from the junction with Hayes Lane, south-eastwards for a total distance of **326 metres**.

This Order will enable **Openreach to lay ducting**.

The Order becomes effective on 19th September 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **25th September 2024** and last until **27th September 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **3 days**. **Revised Hours 09:30 - 15:00**.
