

Somerset Council

Temporary Closure of Bower Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Bower Lane - One Way order preventing traffic from proceeding north westwards from Bridgwater Community Hospital Roundabout to Bath Road Roundabout by Bower Lane - **12th August - 25th August.**

Bower Lane - north exit of Bath Road Roundabout Near Bower Lane - **21st - 25th August.**

Bower Lane - at the junction of Little Sydenham Farm Lane - **26th August - 29th August.**

Full Road Closure - from Junction of Westonzoyland Road to outside Polden Bower School - **9th September - 30th December (site clear 30th October - 3rd November)**
for a total distance of **1926 metres.**

This Order will enable **JSM Group Services to carry out cable installation works on behalf of Indigo.**

The Order becomes effective on 6th August 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. These phased works (as signed on site) are expected to commence on **12th August 2024** and last until **30th December 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **141 days.**
