Temporary Closure of Blackdown Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Blackdown Road - from the junction with Moorlands Road to the junction with Avalon Road. A total distance of **107 metres**.

This Order will enable **Dare Utility Services to carry out remedial reinstatement works on behalf of National Grid**.

The Order becomes effective on 01st October 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **8th October 2024** and last until **10th October 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **3 days**.
