Temporary Closure of Wraxhall Hill and Fosse Way

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Wraxhall Hill - from the junction with Wraxhall Road, northwards for a distance of **700 metres** and **Fosse Way** - from the junction with Hembridge Road, southwards for a distance of **55 metres**.
A total distance of **755 metres**.

This Order will enable **Heidelberg to carry out resurfacing works on behalf of Somerset Highways**.

The Order becomes effective on 30th January 2025 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **03rd February 2025** and last until **11th February 2025** between the hours of **20:00 - 06:00** for a total of **12 nights**.
