Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Holyrood Street - from the junction with High Street and Fore Street, southwards for a distance of 140 metres.

This Order will enable Wessex Water to repair a leaking ferrule.

The Order becomes effective on 5th December 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **10th December 2024** and last until **11th December 2024** between the hours of **18.30 to 06.00 (1 night) - highway will be clear at all other times**.
