Temporary Closure of Dunkery Hill Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;
Dunkery Hill Road - from 220 metres east of the junction with Codsend Road, south-eastwards for a total distance of **45 metres**.

This Order will enable **KIER to repair or construct new pedestrian posts or rails on behalf of Somerset Highways**.

The Order becomes effective on 06th December 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **9th December 2024** and last until **13th December 2024** between the hours of **08:00 - 17:00** for a total of **5 days**.
