

**Somerset Council**

**Temporary Closure of Whitstone Hill**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Whitstone Hill** - from the junction with Top Street to the junction with Bowermead Lane. A total distance of **840 metres**.

This Order will enable **National Grid to carry out pole replacement and tree cutting works**.

The Order becomes effective on 26th December 2024 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **5th January 2025** and last until **2nd February 2025** between the hours of **07:00 - 18:00 (Sunday working only, highway to be clear all other times)** for a total of **5 days**.
