A total distance of **900 metres.**

This Order will enable Wessex Internet to install fibre cabling.

The Order becomes effective on 30th January 2025 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **3rd February 2025** and last until **7th February 2025** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **5 days**.
