

**Somerset Council**  
**Parishes of Puriton and Woolavington**  
**Temporary Closure of Woolavington Road**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

**Woolavington Road** - from Woolavington Road Roundabout, eastwards for a total distance of **1304 metres**.

This Order will enable **M&A Doocey Civil Engineering Ltd to excavate trench to install HV duct/telecom duct/cable and chambers on behalf of National Grid.**

The Order becomes effective on 1st April 2025 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **7th April 2025** and last until **7th September 2025** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **154 days**.
