Temporary Closure of Mark Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:

Mark Road - from 108 metres west of the junction with Baldwins Lane, westwards for a total distance of **45 metres**.

This Order will enable **Bristol Water to carry out new connection works**.

The Order becomes effective on 06th May 2025 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **13th May 2025** and last until **15th May 2025** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **3 days**.
