Temporary Closure of Dunkery Hill Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:

Dunkery Hill Road - from 220 metres south-east of the junction with Codsend Road, south-eastwards for a total distance of **308 metres**.

This Order will enable **Kier to carry out local drainage works on behalf of Somerset Highways**.

The Order becomes effective on 27th June 2025 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **30th June 2025** and last until **4th July 2025** between the hours of **08:00 - 17:00** for a total of **5 days**.
