Temporary Closure of Combe Hill

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:

Combe Hill - from 257 metres south-east of the junction with Bowden Road, south-eastwards for a total distance of **143 metres**.

This Order will enable **Openreach to replace a pole**.

The Order becomes effective on 02nd April 2026 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **9th April 2026** and last until **9th April 2026** between the hours of **09:30 - 15:30** for a total of **6 hours**.
