Temporary Closure of Brewery Lane and Lipyeate Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:

Brewery Lane - from the junction with Lipyeate Cross, westwards for a distance of **452 metres** and

Lipyeate Lane - from the junction with Lipyeate Cross To Luckington Cross, northwards for a distance of **164 metres**.

A total distance of **616 metres**.

This Order will enable **Barr Engineering Services to carry out phased poing works on behalf of Openreach (as and when signed on site)**.

The Order becomes effective on 10th June 2026 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **16th June 2026** and last until **16th June 2026** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **1 day**.
