Temporary Closure of Adcombe Hill and Adcombe Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:

Adcombe Hill - from the junction with Honiton Road, southwards incorporating **Adcombe Lane**, for a total distance of **892 metres**.

This Order will enable **1ServCo** to carry out de-vegetation and overhead cabling works on behalf of **Airband**.

The Order becomes effective on 02nd September 2026 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **7th September 2026** and last until **9th September 2026** between the hours of **09:30 - 15:30** for a total of **3 days**.
