Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(2)
(5 Day Notice)
Quantock Road, Bridgwater
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:

Quantock Road - from the junction with Quantock Road Roundabout, one way direction eastbound only, westbound unaffected for a total distance of **87 metres**

This Notice will come into operation on the **18th March 2026** and will remain in force for a maximum of 5 days. If the works cannot be completed during that period Somerset Council may issue a further Notice under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of that Act. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to commence on **18th March 2026** and last until **18th March 2026** between the hours of **09:30 - 15:00** for a total of **5.5 hours**.

This Order will enable **Kier to reset gully frame works on behalf of Somerset Highways**.
