Temporary Closure of Footpath F1018/1900 Between Elmgrove Close and Whitfield Road, Bridgwater

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order, the effect of which will prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding along;

Footpath F1018/1900 Between Elmgrove Close and Whitfield Road - A total distance of **227 metres**

This Order will enable **National Grid to replace disconnection box and underground cable infrastructure..**

The Order becomes effective on 20th February 2024 and will remain in force for six months. The works are expected to commence on **26th February 2024** and last until **1st March 2024** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **5 days**.
