Temporary Closure of Puriton Hill To Glastonbury Road and Puriton Hill

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Phase 1 - Puriton Hill To Glastonbury Road - from the junction with Glastonbury Road Northwards for 130 metres

Phase 2 - Puriton Hill - from the Junction with Puriton Hill To Glastonbury Road Eastwards for 50 metres.

A total distance 180 metres.

This Order will enable **Alun Griffiths to carry out junction reconfiguration and resurfacing works.**

The Order becomes effective on 17th August 2021 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **23rd August 2021** and last until **19th September 2021** between the hours of **(00:00 - 23:59)** for a total of **28 days**.

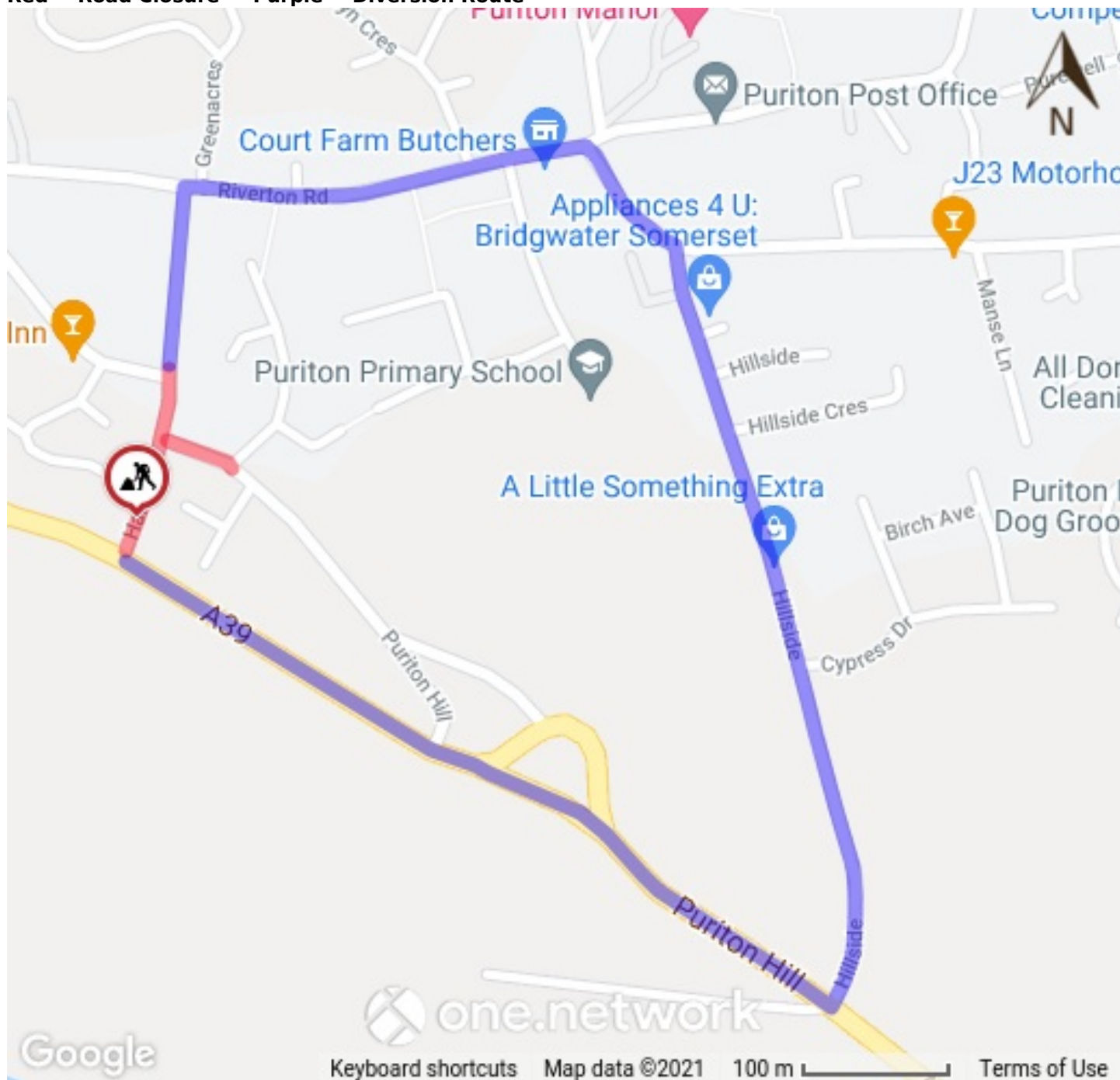
