Notice is hereby given that on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2021 Somerset County Council made the above order in exercise of its powers in the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as previously advertised on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 to introduce a temporary prohibition of vehicles in the road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Order comes into effect on the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
