**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE
EMERGENCY CLOSURE
Long Street
Wheaton Aston**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Staffordshire County Council being the highway authority responsible for the repair and maintenance of Long Street in Wheaton Aston are satisfied that it is necessary to close to all vehicular traffic that length of Long Street from the junction with Caspian Way to the junction with Yew Tree Drive for a period of 21 days from the date of this Notice because of the likelihood of danger to the public during urgent utility works being undertaken by Severn Trent Water.

Access will be available for pedestrians and for vehicles being used in connection with the works and for emergency services vehicles or for vehicles requiring access to properties on the length of road which is closed.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Long Street, High Street, Ivetsey Road, Watling Street, Congreve Lane, Lapley Lane, Stretton Road, Wenlock Bank, Lapley Road, Starkeys Lane and vice versa.
