Uttoxeter
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS Staffordshire County Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Sunnyside Road in Uttoxeter is satisfied that the traffic on the said road in the East Staffordshire District (B) should be restricted by reason of works in connection with positioning of a crane to lift a vessel through the roof, being executed or proposed to be executed therein.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Sunnyside Road in Uttoxeter outside the chocolate factory.
2. The provisions of Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works; or for vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or vehicles requiring access to properties on or immediately adjacent to the said length of road.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 15th August 2024 and may be cited as the Staffordshire County Council Sunnyside Road in Uttoxeter (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024
4. That the following be the preferred alternative route for traffic affected by this Order namely:-

The Preferred alternative route for traffic is
Heath Road
