WHEREAS Staffordshire County Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Marlpit Lane in Denstone is satisfied that the traffic on the said road in the East Staffordshire District (B) should be restricted by reason of works in connection with pole testing works, being executed or proposed to be executed therein.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Marlpit Lane in Denstone from the junction of Alton Road to the junction of the Weavers.

2. The provisions of Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works; or for vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or vehicles requiring access to properties on or immediately adjacent to the said length of road.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 13th May 2025 and may be cited as the Staffordshire County Council Marlpit Lane in Denstone (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2025.

4. That the following be the preferred alternative route for traffic affected by this Order namely:-

The Preferred alternative route for traffic is

Alton Road, Marlpit Lane
