**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY ORDER
Queen Street
Uttoxeter**

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 02/05/2023 intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend the One-Way Order along the full length of Queens Street and prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Queen Street in Uttoxeter from the junction of Queen Street and Market Place between house numbers 9a and 11, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to properties on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 15th May 2023 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26th May 2023.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the installation of non-return valve works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
