**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
Wood Lane
Six Roads End**

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 14th August 2025 intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Wood Lane in Six Roads End from the junction of Wood Lane to the junction of Burton Road unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to properties on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Burton Road, Knightsfield Road, Chapel Lane, Anslow Road, Martins Lane, Wood Lane and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://one.network/?tm=144622551>.

The order will come into operation on 26th August 2025 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28th August 2025.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the blockage clearance and cabling works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
