TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
Greenhill Lane
Wheaton Aston

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 7th April 2026 intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Greenhill Lane in Wheaton Aston, from its junction with Long Street and continuing to its southern-most junction with Ashleigh Crescent, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to properties on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 13th April 2026 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30th June 2026.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the mains renewal works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
