TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
Stretton Road and Lapley Lane
near Stretton

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 15th December 2026 intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Stretton Road and Lapley Lane in Stretton, from Stretton Road's junction with Church Lane to Lapley Lane's junction with Wood Lane, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to properties on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 4th January 2027 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8th February 2027.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the mains renewal works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
