**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
BROOKSIDE ROAD, UTTOXETER**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 17th June 2021 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Brookside Road in Uttoxeter from its junction with the western access of Station Road and continuing in an easterly direction for its entire length unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works, or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and to the train station nearby will be available.

The order will come into operation on 21st June 2021 and the said works commence on or as near as practicable to that date taking place overnight between the hours of 18:00 and 07:00. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20th August 2021.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the S278 works undertaken by Danaher and Walsh, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
