TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC GORSE LANE, FRADLEY

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 11 January 2022 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Gorse Lane in Fradley from its junctions with Hay End Lane, Fradley Junction and Sale Lane for a distance of approximately 555 metres in a south westerly direction unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Gorse Lane, Wood End Lane, A515 Lichfield Road, A513 Alrewas Road, A513 Kings Bromley Road, Alrewas Hayes, Fradley Junction and vice versa. For more information, visit: https://one.network/?tm=124080571.

The order will come into operation on 19 January 2022 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 January 2022.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the tree cutting and cable works undertaken by Openreach, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
