TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ALTON LANE, GREATGATE

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 12 July 2022 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Alton Lane in Greatgate from its junction with Sandy Lane and Croxden Lane to its junction with Bradley Lane unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

The order will come into operation on 21 July 2022 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 July 2022.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the Severn Trent Water works to rebuild an air valve chamber, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
