**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
WOOD LANE, SIX ROADS END**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 12 July 2022 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Wood Lane in Six Roads End from its junction with B5017 Burton Road, A515 Lichfield Road, Newborough Road, Forest Road, A515 Draycott Cliff to its junction with Greaves Lane unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Wood Lane, Martins Lane, Hanbury Hill, Fauld Lane, Coton Lane, A515 Station Road, A515 Main Road, A515 New Row, A515 Draycott Cliff and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://one.network/?tm=128719899>.

The order will come into operation on 18 July 2022 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 July 2022.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the Openreach works install new duct works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
