NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 12 July 2022 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Common Lane in Fradley adjacent to its junction with Bridge Farm Lane unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Wood End Lane, A38 Rykneld Street, Northbound Slip Roads at A38 junction Fradley, Fradley Lane, Church Lane, Hay End Lane, Common Lane and vice versa via Hay End Lane, Church Lane, Fradley Lane, Fine Line, A38 Rykneld Street, Wood End Lane. The order will come into operation on 21 July 2022 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29 July 2022.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the S278 road improvements to include kerbing, surfacing, new bellmouth to Bellway Homes Development and a raised table for traffic calming works undertaken by M&J Evans Construction, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
