WHEREAS the Staffordshire County Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for A513 Kings Bromley Road near Alrewas is satisfied that the traffic on the said road in the District of Lichfield should be restricted by reason of works in connection with work to carry out trial holes to prove route then lay approx. 260mtrs x 110mm PE and make connection onto existing 110mm PVC main being executed or proposed to be executed therein.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall drive any vehicles at a speed exceeding 40M.P.H. on A513 Kings Bromley Road near Alrewas from its junction with Alrewas Hayes, Orgreave and continuing for a distance of approximately 850 metres in a generally easterly direction.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th September 2023 and may be cited as the Staffordshire County Council A513 Kings Bromley Road, near Alrewas (Temporary 40 M.P.H. Speed Restriction) Order 2023..
