TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE

Various Streets
East Staffordshire

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Staffordshire County Council being the highway authority responsible for the repair and maintenance of Castle Hayes Lane in Tutbury, Carlton Street in Burton Upon Trent, Main Road in Draycott in the Clay, Newborough Road in Six Roads End, Roost Hill in Newborough and Newborough Road, School Hill and Maker Lane in Hoar Cross are satisfied that it is necessary to Close that length of Castle Hayes Lane, Carlton Street, Main Road, Newborough Road, Roost Hill, Newborough Road, School Hill and Marker Lane for the whole length of the road for a period of 5 days but no more than 5 days from 22nd July 2024 because of the likelihood of danger to the public during mutiple pothole repair works being undertaken by Staffordshire County Council.

Access will be available for pedestrians and for vehicles being used in connection with the works and for emergency services vehicles or for vehicles requiring access to properties on the length of road which is closed.

An alternative route for traffic is available and will be signed on site.
