#### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ACCESS ON HIGHWAYS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Network Rail by reason of works proposed to be carried out on or near the highway identified below intends to bring into effect the Order of which will be that no person shall be permitted to proceed in that length of Station Road, Mirfield from its junction with Lowlands Road to its junction with Back Station Road **PROVIDED THAT** such prohibition shall not extend to users in connection with the works to be carried out on or near the closed length of highway or to users requiring access up to the point(s) of the closure.

Back Station Road, Newgate, Huddersfield Road, Station Road - Vice Versa


