

Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Urgent Closure of: Burton Hill, Malmesbury

WILTSHIRE COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that on 22nd May 2026, the following length of road shall be closed to all traffic in the interests of public safety to enable Wiltshire Council to carry out urgent zebra-crossing restoration works and other associated works.

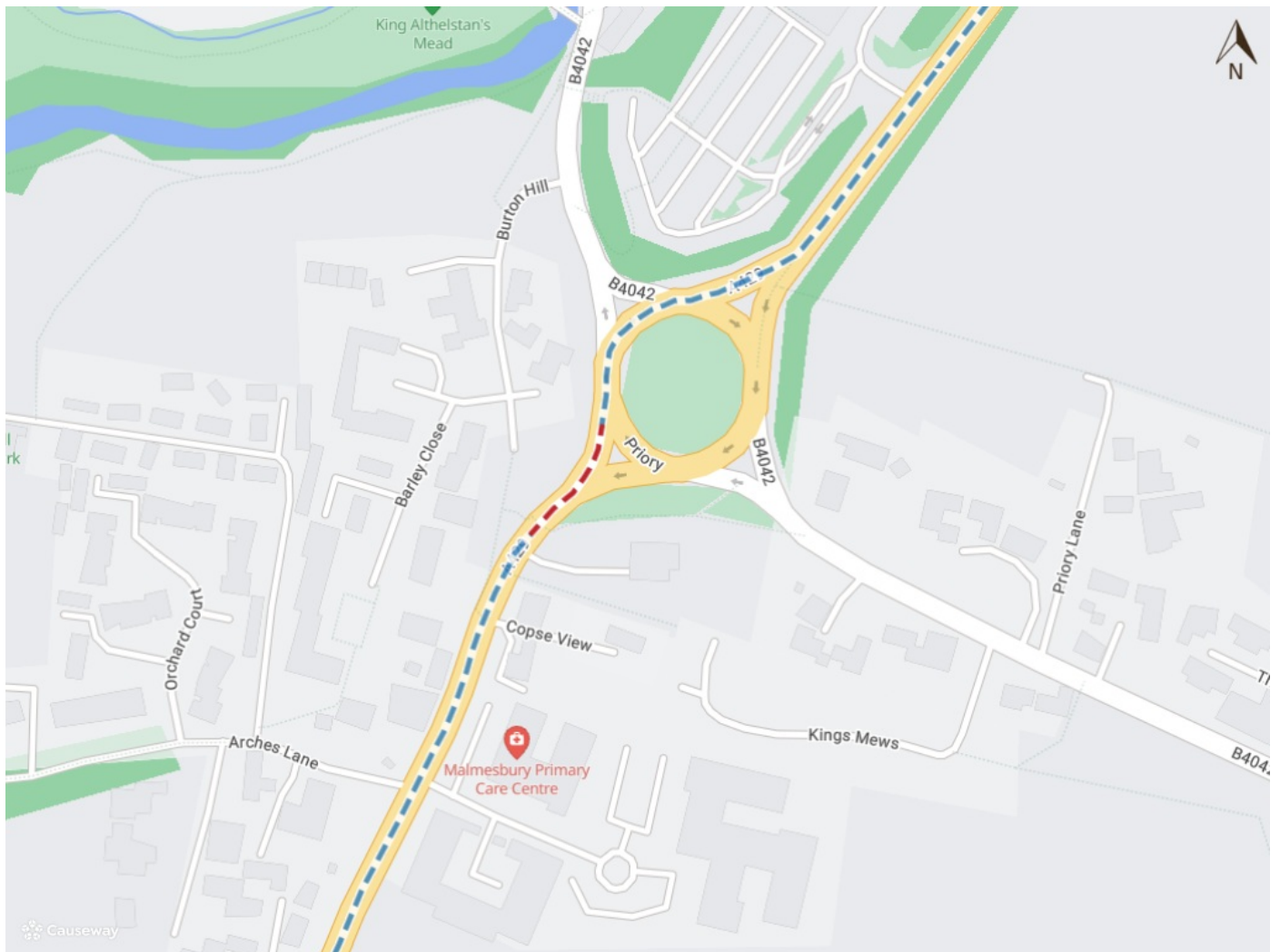
Burton Hill, Malmesbury; for approximately 57m in a North-Easterly direction to its junction with Malmesbury By-pass.

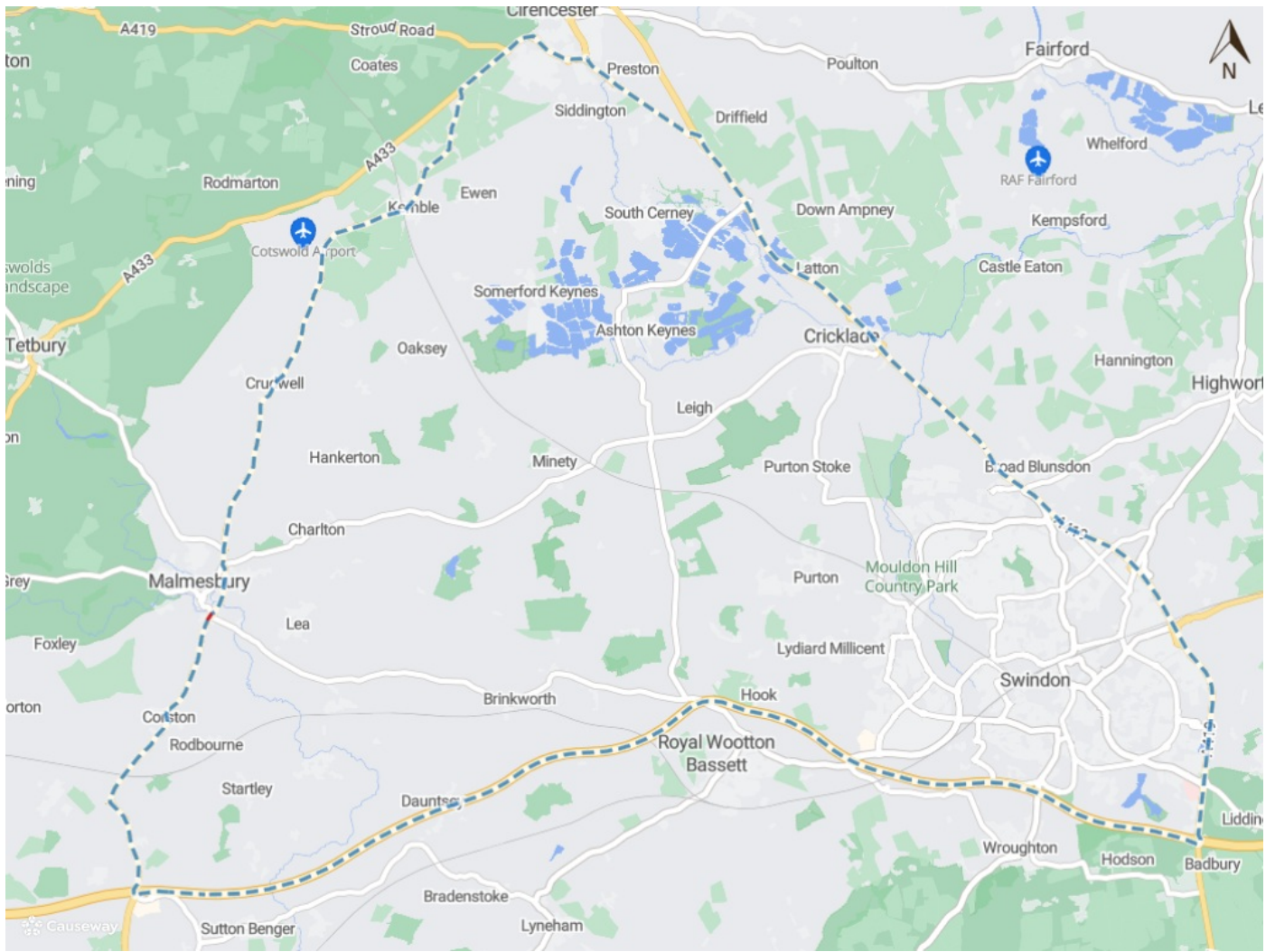
Alternative route: via Malmesbury By-pass, A429, A419, Badbury Roundabout, M4, Stanton St Quintin Interchange, A429, Burton Hill A429 (Unaffected length) and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works.

These works will commence on 22nd May 2026 and are anticipated to be required for 1 night between the hours of 19:00 and 23:59. This Notice will have a maximum duration of 5 days.
