

Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Urgent Closure of: Livery Road (part), Winterslow

WILTSHIRE COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that on 19th March 2026, the following length of road shall be closed to all traffic in the interests of public safety to enable M Group on behalf of Wiltshire Council to carry out carriageway patching and other associated works.

Livery Road (part), Winterslow; from its junction with Back Drove for approximately 117 meters North.

and

Livery Road (part), Winterslow; from approximately 60 meters North of the entrance to the property known as Poultry Farm Livery Road for approximately 30 meters North.

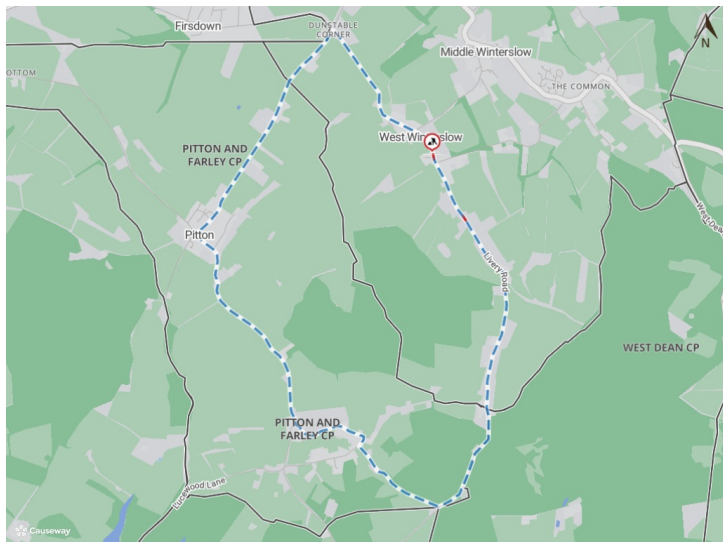
Both areas will not be closed at the same time and will be done in succession of each other

Alternative route: via Livery Road unaffected length, Pitton Road, White Hill, Church Road and Ben Lane and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works.

These works will commence on 19th March 2026 and are anticipated to be required for one day between the hours of 09:00 and 16:00. This Notice will have a maximum duration of 5 days.
