Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Closure of: Ingram Street, Malmesbury (Ref: TTRO 9648)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to:

Close temporarily to all traffic:

Ingram Street, Malmesbury; from its junction with High Street to its junction with Silver Street.

And to temporarily suspend the existing prohibition order of no entry for vehicles from Cross Hayes junction into Silver Street to facilitate for diversion for traffic.

To enable: Openreach to carry out access to underground network to install fibre cables and associated works.

Alternative route A: via High Street – Oxford Street – Cross Hayes – Silver Street.

Alternative route B: via Silver Street – St Dennis Road – High Street.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

This Order will come into operation on 12 August 2024 and the closure will be required between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30 for 5 days. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
