

Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Urgent Closure of: B3098 (Part), Erlestoke

WILTSHIRE COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that on 22nd May 2024, the following length of road shall be closed to all Pedestrians, Equestrians, non-motorised vehicles and motor propelled vehicles in the interests of public safety to enable Wiltshire Council to carry out Carriageway resurfacing and associated works.

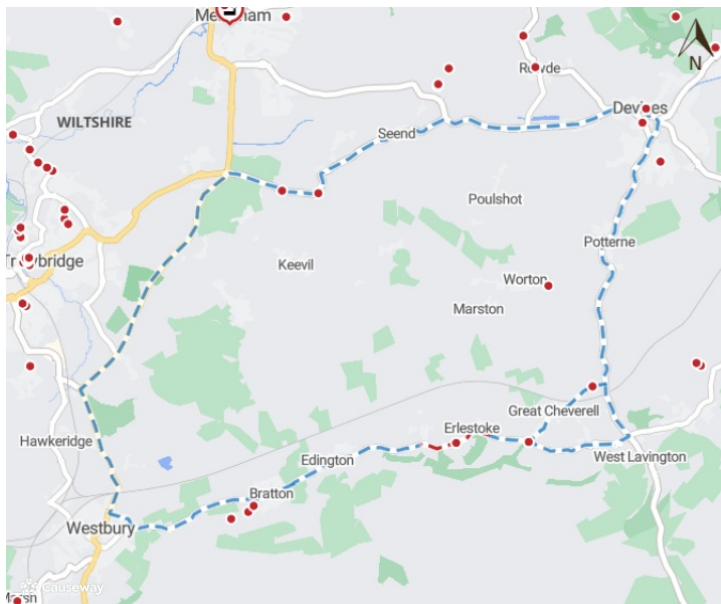
B3098 (Part), Erlestoke; from property known as Banyton lodge to the property known as Erlestoke Prison .

Alternative route: via Alternative diversion route for high sided vehicles: via B3098 (unaffected length), C40, A360, A361, A350, Bitham Park, B3098 (unaffected length) and vice versa. Alternative route for all other vehicles: via B3098 (unaffected length), A360, A361, A350, Bitham Park, B3098 (unaffected length) and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works.

These works will commence on 22nd May 2024 and are anticipated to be required until 25th May 2024 between the hours of 19:00 and 23:59. This Notice will have a maximum duration of 05 days.
