
U2155 HESKET NEWMARKET

Notice is hereby given, that because of the likelihood of danger to the public, as a result of carriageway defects Cumberland Council hereby prohibits the passage of vehicles along that section of the U2155 from its junction with C2055, extending in an overall southernly direction for a distance of approximately 2.8 km.

This notice will be in force for a period of up to 21 days from 11th March 2024, as and when the relevant signs are displayed. It is anticipated that the restriction will be required for 9 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be available via the unrestricted sections of the C2055.

Nothing in this Notice shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with any repair works.
