

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**SECTION 14(2): EMERGENCY TEMPORARY**  
**PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC**

**U1048, WEST HALL, BRAMPTON**

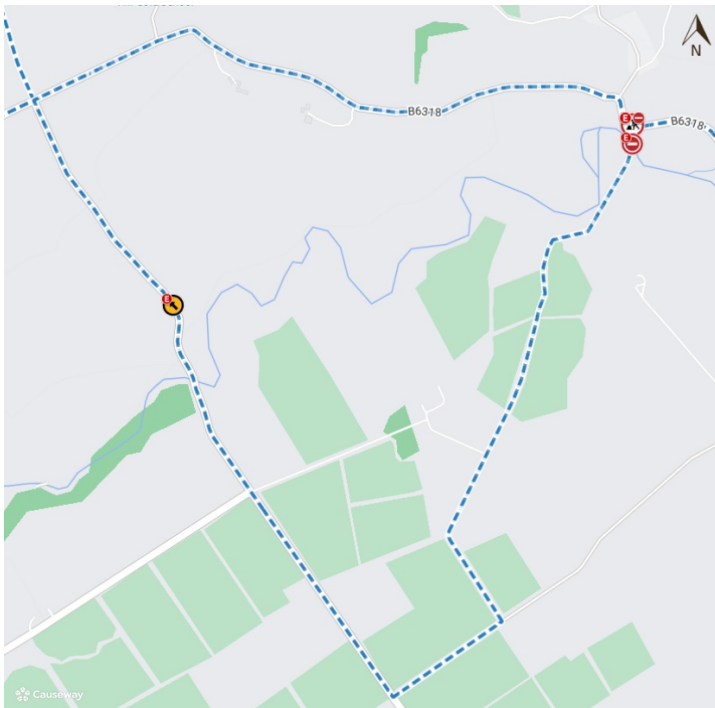
Notice is hereby given, that because of the likelihood of danger to the public, as a result of ford collapse, Cumberland Council hereby prohibits the passage of vehicles along that section of U1048, West Hall, Brampton from a point approx. 20m south of its junction with B6318, extending in a South direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres.

**This notice will be in force for a period of up to 21 days from 9th July 2025, as and when the relevant signs are displayed. It is anticipated that the restriction will be required for 21 days.**

It is likely that after this time we will issue a second 21 day notice and if necessary, follow that with a Temporary 18 months Order.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be available via the unrestricted sections of the U1048, U1050, C1025 and B6318.

Nothing in this Notice shall:

1. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
2. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
3. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with any repair works.
