URGENT ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE


C2023 HAYTON, ASPATRIA

Notice is hereby given that to enable Fibrus to carry out urgent repair works ("the Works"), Cumberland Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicular traffic along that section of C2023 Hayton, Aspatria from its junction with the A596, extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 1150 metres, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 20th November 2024. It is expected that the Works will take 3 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of the A595, C2024 and C2023.

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
