CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN SILLOTH) (SOLWAY COAST CYCLING FESTIVAL) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate the holding of the Solway Coast Cycling Festival ("the Event") in Silloth, Cumberland Council intends to make an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 1984 Act), the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from proceeding along the following lengths of road;

1. B5302 Criffel Street, Silloth from its junction with Petteril Street to its junction with Eden Street.

<u>Alternative Route</u>: via the unrestricted section of the B5302 Petteril Street, Solway Street and B5301 Eden Street.

2. U2251 Station Road, Silloth from its junction with the B5302 Eden Street extending in a Southerly direction for approx. 120m.

There is no suitable alternative route available for motor vehicles.

- 3. Esk Street, Silloth from its junction with Church Terrace to its junction with the B5302 Criffel Street.
- 4. Church Terrace, Silloth from its junction with Caldew Street to its junction with Esk Street.
- 5. Caldew Street, Silloth from its junction with B5302 Criffel Street to its junction with Church Terrace.

<u>Alternative Route for 3 to 4 above</u>: via the unrestricted section of the Esk Street, Solway Street and Caldew Street.

A way for pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- (i) Apply to emergency service motor vehicles, or motor vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- (ii) Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform: and
- (iii) Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- (iv)Apply to motor vehicles being used in connection with the Event.
- (v)Apply to motor vehicles requiring access to the Lifeboat slipway and involved in the operation of the Lifeboat Station

The Order will come into operation on 4 June 2023 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of three days from that date. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required 1 day on Sunday 4 June 2023 and only between the hours of 0900 and 1630, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed
