

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (BROOMFALLEN ROAD, SCOTBY AND MARKS AVENUE,
CARLISLE) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Morrison Telecom Services to carry out utility works ("the Works"), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. Broomfallen Road, Scotby, from a point approx. 1km north west of its junction with the B6263 Cumwhinton Road, extending in a north westerly direction for approx. 270m.
Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of Broomfallen Road, the B6263, Steeles Bank, Wetheral and Scotby Road.

Duration: From 16 October 2023 for approx. 2 days (Ref: TTRO/8390)

2. Marks Avenue, Carlisle, from its junction with Shady Grove Road to its junction with Thomlinson Avenue.

Alternative Route for North West Bound Vehicles: via Shady Grove Road and Thomlinson Avenue.

Duration: From 16 October 2023 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTRO/8391)

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- (i) Apply emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- (ii) Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- (iii) Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- (iv) Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.

The Order will come into operation on 16 October 2023 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
