

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (CLIFF ROAD SANDYSIKE)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of Cliff Road, Sandysike from a point approx. 170m south east of its junction with the A7, extending in a north easterly direction for approx. 150m.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of Cliff Road, C1007, A6071, Albert Street, Longtown, Carlisle Road and the A7.

The Order will come into operation on 7 November 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restriction will only be required for 2 days and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
