

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (U1046 STAPLETON, U1088 SMITHFIELD AND C1007 NEAR LONGTOWN) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. U1046 Stapleton, from its junction with the track leading to St Mary’s Church, extending in a south easterly direction for approx. 140m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the U1046, U1045 and C1012.

Duration: From 30 January 2025 for approx. 1 day between 0830 and 1530 hours (Ref: TTROC/13305)

2. U1088 Smithfield, from its junction with the A6071, extending in a north easterly direction for approx. 100m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of the U1088, C1030 and A6071.

Duration: From 6 February 2025 for approx. 1 day between 0830 and 1530 hours (Ref: TTROC/13313)

3. C1007 near Longtown, from a point approx. 930m south west of its junction with the C1004, extending in a south westerly direction for approx. 230m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the C1007, C1004, C1003, A7 and A6071.

Duration: From 11 February 2025 for approx. 1 day between 0830 and 1530 hours (Ref: TTROC/13397)

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation on 30 January 2025 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
