

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (U1153 UNTHANK, C2047 WEST CURTHWAITE AND U1055  
LOW ROW) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works"), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. U1153 Unthank, from a point adjacent to the property known as Sprunston Farm, extending in a south westerly direction for approx. 100m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the U1153, C1036 and C1017.

**Duration: From 11 March 2026 for approx. 2 days between 0830 and 1630 hours each day (Ref: TTROC/17353)**

2. C2047 West Curthwaite, from a point adjacent to The Oak Pub, extending in a south westerly direction for approx. 110m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the C2047 and C2048.

**Duration: From 11 March 2026 for approx. 2 days between 0830 and 1630 hours each day (Ref: TTROC/17361)**

3. U1055 Low Row, from its junction with the C1023, extending in a south easterly direction for approx. 990m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of the U1055, A69 and C1023.

**Duration: From 17 March 2026 for approx. 2 days between 0830 and 1630 (Ref: TTROC/17455)**

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times

The Order will come into operation on 11 March 2026 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
