

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (C1013 CORBY HILL, WARWICK BRIDGE AND
CHATSWORTH SQUARE, CARLISLE) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION)
ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. C1013 Corby Hill, Warwick Bridge, from its junction with Hurley Road, extending in a south easterly direction for approx. 70m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of the C1013, Little Corby Road and the A69.

Duration: From 18 May 2026 for approx. 5 days (Ref: TTROC/18160)

2. Chatsworth Square, Carlisle, from its junction with Victoria Place, extending in a south easterly direction for approx. 20m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of Chatsworth Square, Hartington Place and Victoria Place.

Duration: From 25 May 2026 for approx. 10 days (Ref: TTROC/18239)

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times

The Order will come into operation on 18 May 2026 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
